

I've downloaded the latest RS-SQL Release ISO image file from the O'Neil Software website, now what do I do?

Option 1

If you want to burn the .ISO image (write it) to an attached CD/DVD burner, you should just double click on the file name. You will be prompted with the following dialog that will ask for the path to your CD/DVD writer drive. If a writer is found, your status will indicate such. Ensure the "Verify disc after burning" box is checked.




Option 2

If you would like to mount the file so it appears like a CD on your machine, just right click on the file and click on the **Mount** option. The ISO file will create a new drive letter with the name of the ISO file displayed next to the drive letter. Some older operating systems may not have this option.

Option 3

If you would like to extract the ISO file to a folder, you should use an ISO extraction program.

O'Neil Software currently recommends 7-Zip (<http://www.7-zip.org>). To download 7-Zip, click on the Download link near the top of the page. Be sure to select the proper version depending on whether your machine is 32-bit or 64-bit. The 7-Zip installation file should create a link at the bottom of your browser page. To install 7-Zip, double click on the link at the bottom of your browser page.

Download 7-Zip 15.14 (2015-12-31) for Windows:

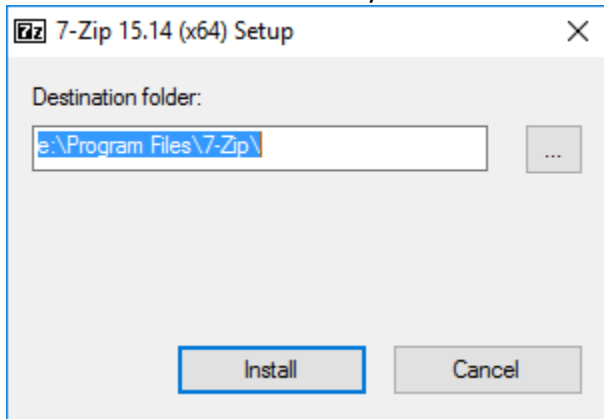

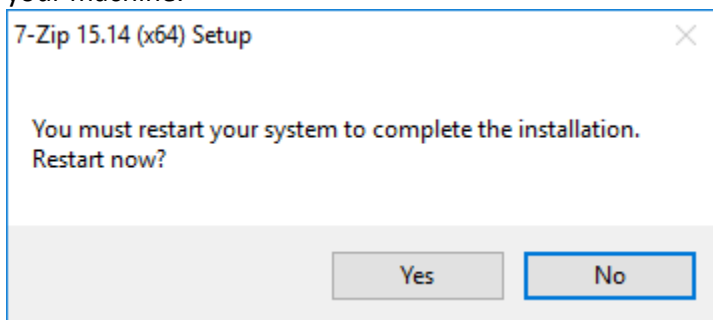
7-Zip is open source software. Most of the source code is under the GNU LGPL license. The unrar code is under a mixed license: GNU LGPL + unrar restrictions. Check license information here: [7-Zip license](#).

You can use 7-Zip on any computer, including a computer in a commercial organization. You don't need to register or pay for 7-Zip.

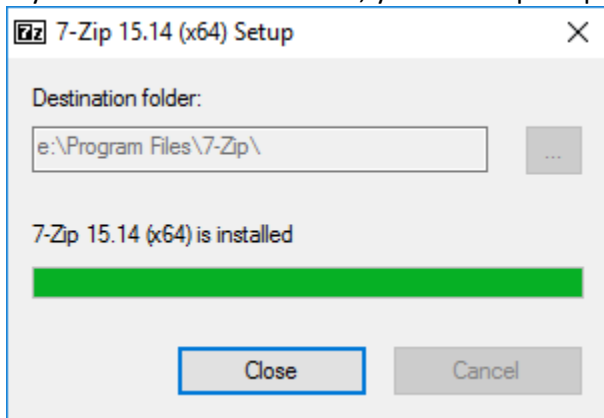
Select the destination folder you would like to use and click on the Install button.



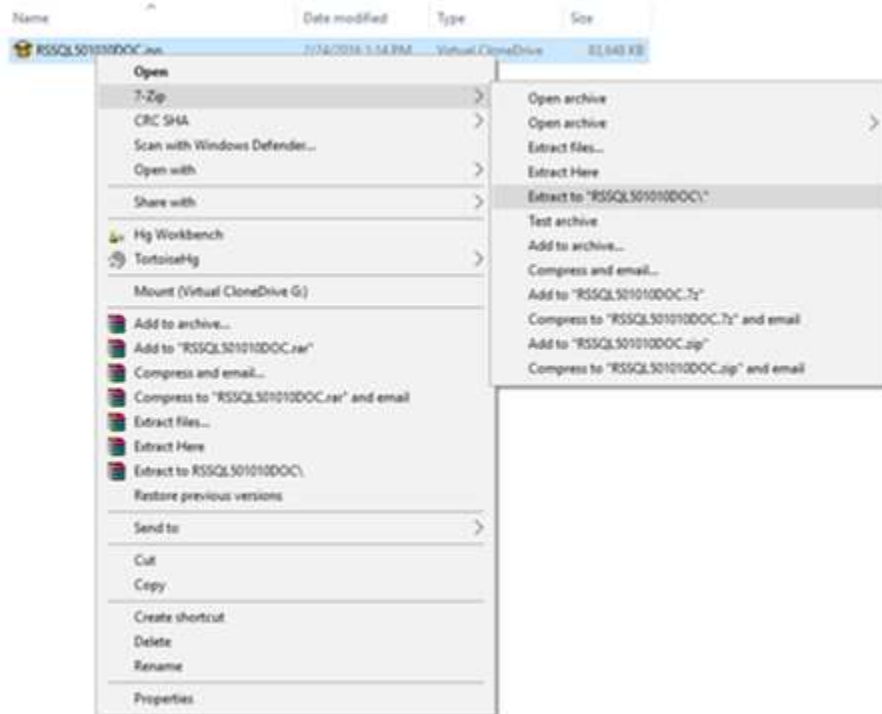
You may be asked if you would like to restart your machine. If it is safe to do so, click on the Yes button to restart your machine.



If you click on the No button, you will be prompted with the following window. Click on the Close button.



To open the RS-SQL image, open Windows Explorer, find the RS-SQL ISO file you have downloaded and right click on the file name. Select 7-Zip. Select Extract to [filename]. The file will extract into the folder named in the menu selection. See below.



Double click on the new folder and install as usual.
